The mission of the Goldie B. Wolfe Miller Women Leaders in Real Estate® Initiative ("The Goldie Initiative") is to prepare women for senior leadership roles in all sectors of commercial real estate. The Goldie Initiative does this by providing scholarship support for graduate study, mentorship and networking opportunities to women with high potential who are committed to becoming the leaders in the real estate industry.

My role as founder of The Goldie Initiative® has evolved since our organization was established in 2007. I continue to remain actively involved on the Board of Directors, in the Goldie Scholar® interview process, and as a fundraiser and presenter at the Goldie Gala. One of my favorite programs in The Goldie Initiative is hosting "Wednesdays with Goldie" during the winter and spring months. Each Wednesday morning, I connect for a 45-minute one-on-one Zoom meeting with one or two current Goldie Scholars. For at least five years, I have spoken with dozens of Goldie Scholars about a myriad of topics.

There are no agendas for the "Wednesdays with Goldie" meetings. The Scholars lead the discussion. Following are a few of the most popular topics during my conversations with Goldie Scholars, who, by the way, are among the most driven, ambitious, and positive individuals I get to meet with every year.

- How to look for a job and interview tips
- Navigating the tough commercial real estate market
- Managing stress and career pathways
- Other private or personal issues such as confidence, taking risks, making mistakes, and how to "pivot"

During these meetings, Goldie Scholars share a lot with me, and often ask for advice. We get to know one another, and I learn about their unique challenges. We also discuss their experience as a Goldie Scholar, including the impact of our mentors, our leadership development programs and networking events. I even ask them how they would improve/change the Initiative.

Most of all, they thanked me for the resources provided by The Goldie Initiative and our fantastic team of staff and board, mentors, and volunteer contributors. So, I THANK YOU ON THEIR BEHALF.

Finally, I am grateful for the opportunity to connect one-on-one with each Goldie Scholar as part of our program! And I am proud of how we are making a difference in their lives... and making a positive impact in our real estate industry.

Each Goldie Scholar is matched with a Mentor to share interactions that lead to a life-changing and career-developing relationship.




We provide tools and opportunities to help Scholars learn to negotiate the industry and advocate for themselves as they advance in their careers.






#### EXPENSES & REVENUES (2019-2023)

## STRATEGIC PLAN 2024-2026

In 2023, The Goldie Initiative Board of Directors engaged in a Strategic Planning Process, to build upon organizational success and lay the groundwork for future activities, through 2026. Following are highlights from that process.

#### Revised Mission

The Goldie Initiative prepares women to advance as leaders in commercial real estate by providing financial and professional support.

#### **GOALS & OBJECTIVES**

#### **EXPAND**

- By 2026, physically expand the leadership structure into one additional market (Northeast) serving local scholars outside of the Midwest.
- Continually improve the quality of experience for scholars who are able only to participate virtually.

#### **ENGAGE**

- By 2026, 50% of Goldie Scholar alumnae remain actively engaged with TGI.
- Engage TGI's community within expansion markets to represent an adequate number of professionals to support Scholars locally.
- 80% of Goldie mentors and leaders remain actively engaged with TGI.

#### RESOURCE

- By 2026, revenue sources outside of TGI Gala represent a minimum of 30 percent of total revenue.
